Dual Enrollment:

If you are taking dual enrollment classes through Tri-County Technical College, classes begin on Monday, **August 20**. Dual enrollment classes count towards your high school and cumulative college GPA so please take these classes very seriously. Tuition must be paid by August 14 at 6:00pm. Last day to drop a DE class is August 24. DE students will follow the TCTC schedule.

Graduation Supplies:
